PARENT INFORMATION

This sheet is for the parents/guardians of participants attending Rocky Mountain High.

WHAT

The mission of Rocky is: To provide a large group encounter with the transformational truth and love of Jesus for students and leaders.

Rocky is an experience for churched and non-churched young people and adult leaders that challenges them to begin or deepen a faith in Christ that impacts their life.

This year the theme for Rocky is AMPLIFY. We're going to dive into the book of Colossians and study a chapter a day!!! We couldn't pick just one "verse" so we decided to go for the whole book!!! During the event, your young person will be taking part in worship, seminars, recreation, youth group time, and much more!

WHEN

Dates Saturday, July 23 (*Registration begins @ 3:00pm*)

Wednesday, July 27 (*Depart @ 8:00am*)

NOTE: Depending on the plans and schedule of your church group, your young person may be leaving earlier or later than the times given here.
